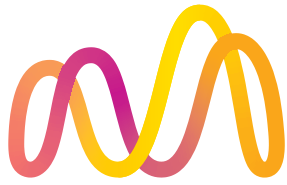

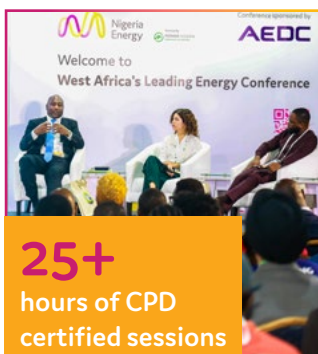


Accelerating sustainable energy supply in Nigeria
